

# ICORP SECURITY SUPPLIER CODE OF CONDUCT

#### Introduction

ICORP Security is committed to upholding ethical standards in all business operations. This Supplier Code of Conduct outlines our expectations for suppliers, contractors, and partners regarding fair labour practices, human rights, and environmental stewardship. All suppliers must comply with this Code as a condition of doing business with ICORP Security.

#### **Labour Standards**

## Forced Labour:

#### Child Labour:
